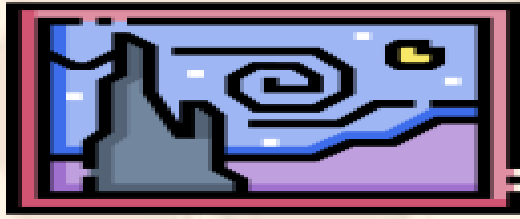

TRIP TO RAJASTHAN –CLASS 11TH AND 12TH

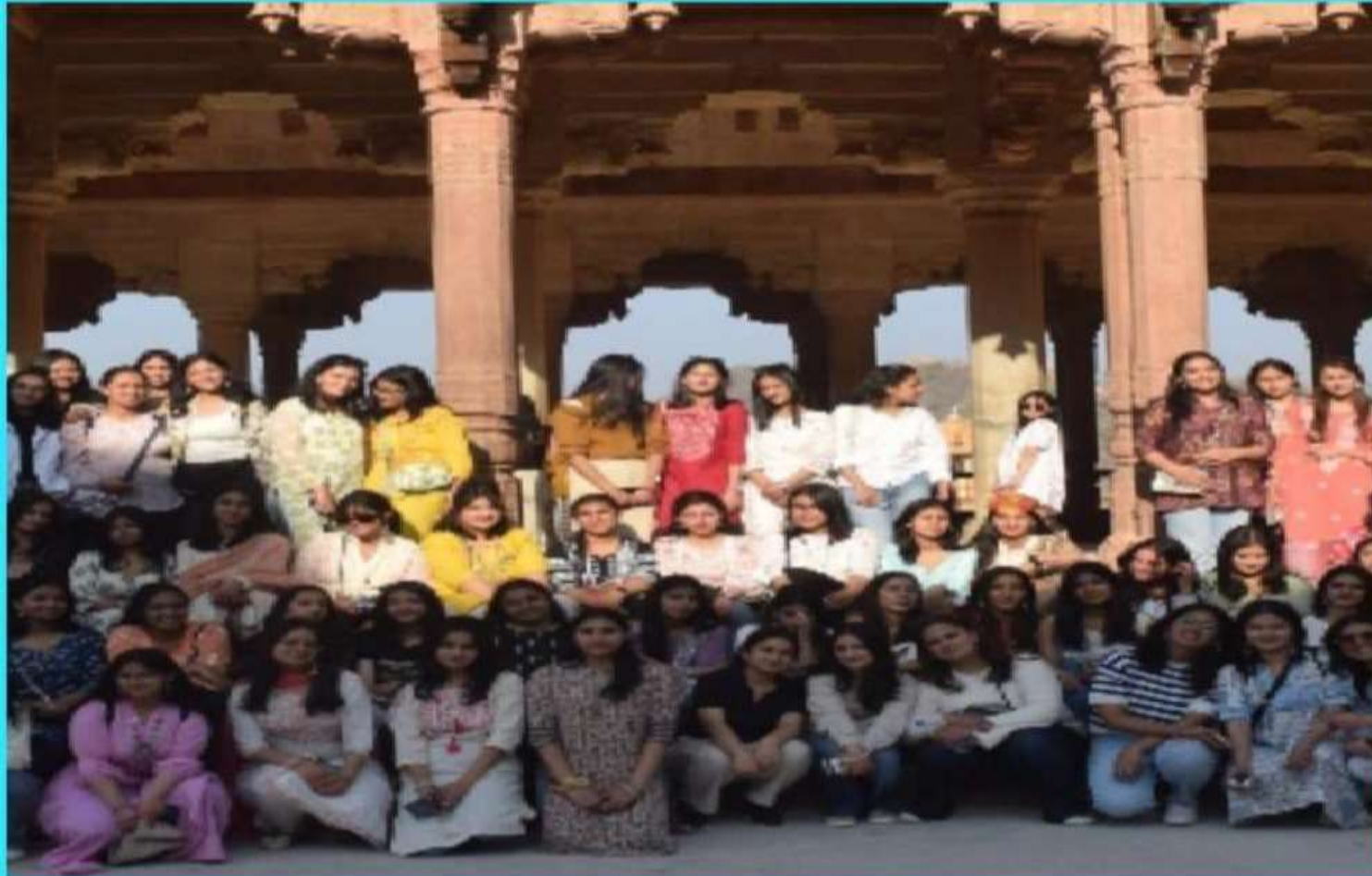

Their first visit was to **the Amer Fort** which is a treasure house of great hidden history. Later they were taken to **Jal Mahal** for sightseeing.

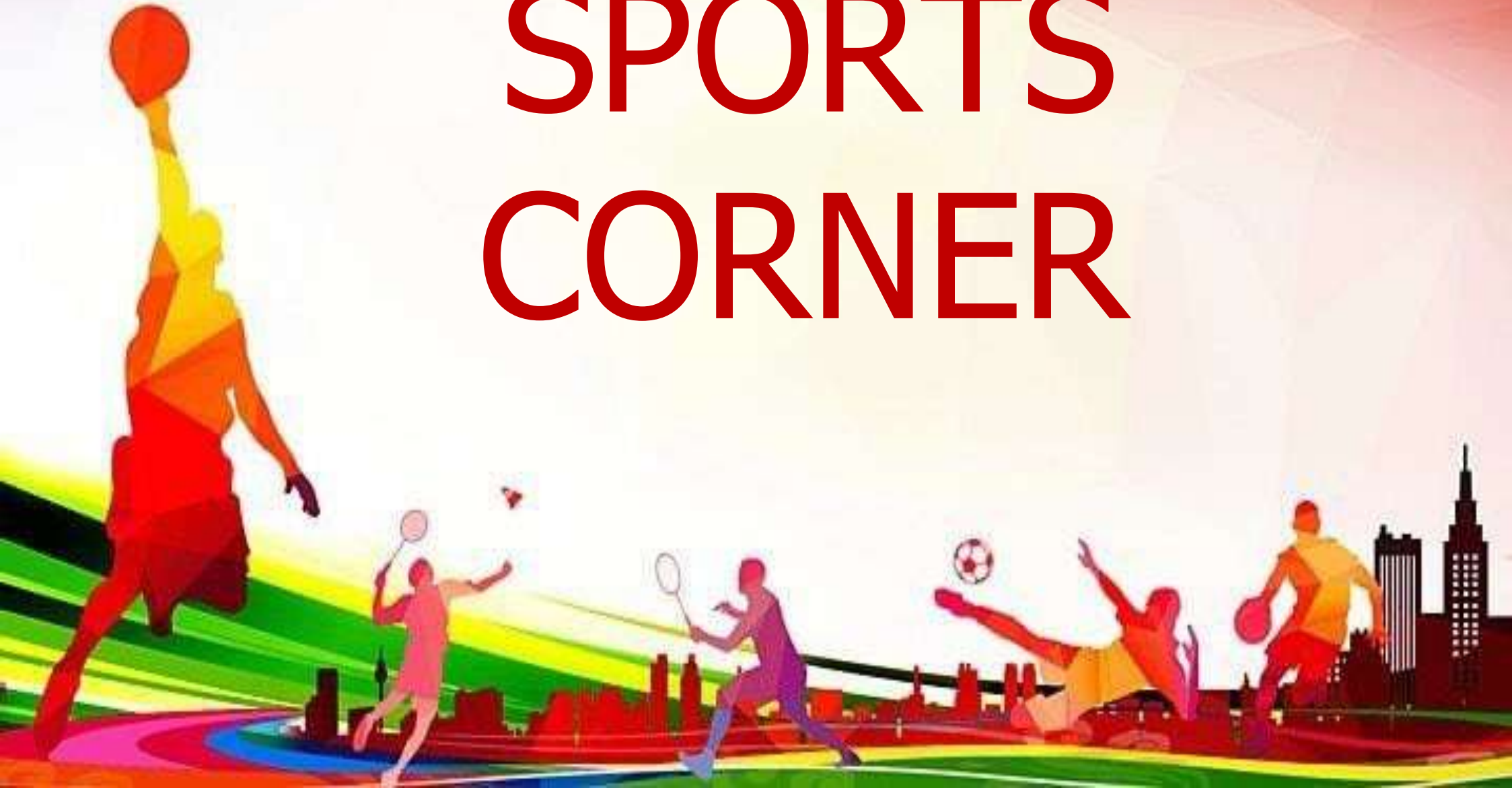
